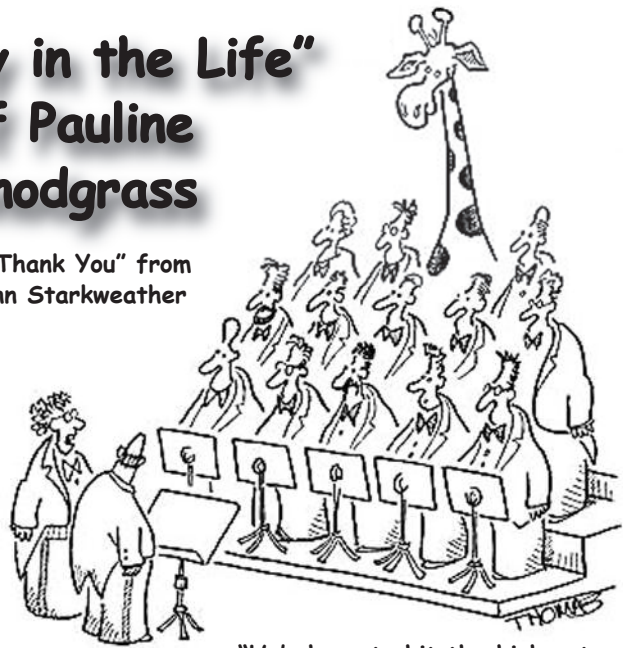

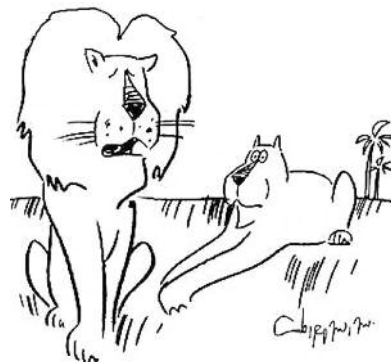

PIANO LESSONS

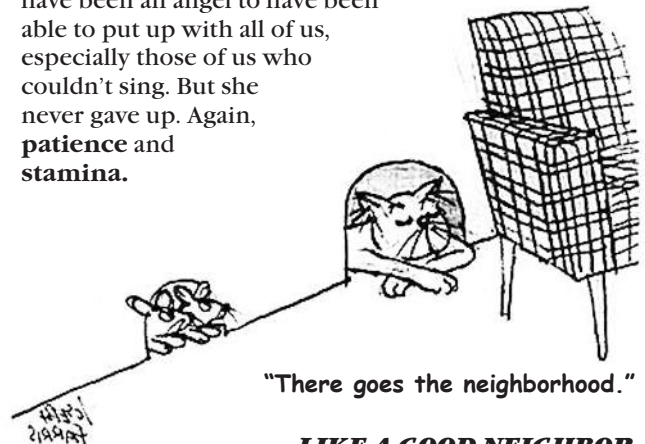
